

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK Parliamentary Election

For the Bury St Edmunds constituency

1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament for Bury St Edmunds.
2. Nomination papers for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained at West Suffolk House, Western Way, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk, IP33 3YU from the (Acting) Returning Officer who will, at the request of an elector for any electoral area prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the (Acting) Returning Officer, West Suffolk House, Western Way, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk, IP33 3YU on any day after the date of this notice between the hours of 10am and 4pm but no later than 4pm on Thursday 14th November 2019.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender or by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom. The deposit may alternatively be made by electronic transfer to West Suffolk Council.
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday 12th December 2019.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 26th November 2019.
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Suffolk House, Western Way, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk, IP33 3YU by 5pm on Tuesday 26th November 2019.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Suffolk House, Western Way, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk, IP33 3YU by 5pm on Wednesday 4th December 2019.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at West Suffolk House, Western Way, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk, IP33 3YU by 5pm on Thursday 12th December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 4th December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 4th December 2019.
